

Risk of Coronavirus (COVID-19) Transmission at Back In Line Complementary Therapy Centre

This Form is in addition to consent form for chiropractic examination and treatment

The Government published a Statutory Instrument on 26th March 2020, **no. 350 ‘The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) Regulations 2020’** confirming that it is lawful for a chiropractic practice to remain open. It further defines those people who are recognised as vulnerable for the purposes of document.

Back In Line Complementary Therapy Centre has conducted a thorough risk assessment to ensure adequate levels of safety at this clinic are implemented and maintained. We are following the most up-to-date Government and Public Health England guidance and put in place stringent patient triage, hygiene, sanitation and infection control protocols to protect our patients and staff/ team members. Despite these precautions, there is a risk of transmission of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and it is important that you understand the risk. We have provided the information below to help you decide if you wish to continue with your care at Back in Line Complementary Therapy Centre and remind you that you are under no obligation to do so.

Precautions that Back In Line Complementary Therapy Centre has in place:

- All patients contacting us for an appointment are triaged by a trained healthcare professional (usually a chiropractor) over the telephone to establish whether symptoms are present, if they are self-isolating, if anyone in their household has symptoms or is self-isolating, or they have been in contact with anyone with COVID-19 symptoms.
- We enforce a strict policy that anyone with any COVID-19 symptoms must stay away from the clinic.
- A second triage is conducted at the Clinic, including a temperature check.
- A strict cleaning, sanitation and infection control protocol is adhered to – Please ask if you would like to see this document.
- All team members at Back In Line Complementary Therapy Centre adhere to the social distancing guidance issued by the Government.
- The layout of the practice has been adapted to maintain social distancing.
- Patients waiting are restricted to one at any time and a 2-metre distance will be enforced between patients and non-clinical team members.
- Chiropractors and Clinical Staff will be wearing Personal Protective Equipment for your protection.

Back In Line Complementary Therapy Centre is committed to ensuring that every measure is in place to minimise the risk of exposure to COVID-19, we cannot guarantee there is no risk to you as a result of attending the clinic.

Eligibility for Care

We are unable to offer face-to-face appointments to the following people:

If you are self-isolating - until your isolation period is over and you have no symptoms; you have COVID-19 symptoms (whether diagnosed by test or not); if you are living with someone with COVID-19 symptoms (whether diagnosed by test or not); you have been in contact with anyone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 and have been asked to self-isolate for 14 days by the Contact Tracing Service.

We are currently unable to accept patients from the vulnerable “High Risk” groups defined by the NHS below:

1. Solid organ transplant recipients.
2. People with specific cancers:
 - People with cancer who are undergoing active chemotherapy
 - People with lung cancer who are undergoing radical radiotherapy
 - People with cancers of the blood or bone marrow such as leukaemia, lymphoma or myeloma who are at any stage of treatment
 - People having immunotherapy or other continuing antibody treatments for cancer
 - People having other targeted cancer treatments which can affect the immune system, such as protein kinase inhibitors or PARP inhibitors
 - People who have had bone marrow or stem cell transplants in the last 6 months, or who are still taking immunosuppression drugs
3. People with severe respiratory conditions including all cystic fibrosis, severe asthma and severe chronic obstructive pulmonary (COPD).
4. People with rare diseases and inborn errors of metabolism that significantly increase the risk of infections (such as Severe combined immunodeficiency (SCID), homozygous sickle cell).
5. People on immunosuppression therapies sufficient to significantly increase risk of infection.
6. Women who are pregnant with significant heart disease, congenital or acquired.

If you are in the “Moderate Risk” group as defined by the NHS below, we may be able to offer you a face to face appointment if it is deemed safe to do so.

- Pregnant

- Over 70

- Have a long-term health condition/ Underlying Medical Conditions as listed below:

- Chronic (long-term) respiratory diseases, such as asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, emphysema or bronchitis.
- Chronic heart disease, such as heart failure.
- Chronic kidney disease.
- Chronic liver disease, such as hepatitis.
- Chronic neurological conditions, such as Parkinson’s disease, motor neurone disease, multiple sclerosis, a learning disability or cerebral palsy.
- Diabetes.
- Problems with the spleen, such as sickle cell disease or removal of the spleen.
- A weakened immune system as the result of conditions such as HIV and AIDS, or medicines such as steroid tablets or chemotherapy.
- Being seriously overweight, with a body mass index of 40 or above.

By attending Back in Line Complementary Therapy Centre, I can confirm all of the below remain correct and accurate:

- I have answered all questions (triage) relating to my potential exposure to Coronavirus (COVID-19) truthfully.
- I understand that there is a potential risk of transmission of Coronavirus (COVID-19) as a result of attending the clinic and/or receiving treatment.
- I have had the opportunity to ask all the questions I wish to, and all my questions have been answered to my satisfaction.
- I have read, agreed to and understood the statements above relating to Coronavirus (COVID-19) risk and consent to receive care at Back In Line Complementary Therapy Centre.
- I understand and agree that I will need to give separate consent regarding my chiropractic care.

Should I have further questions that arise between submitting this form and up to and including when my appointment starts, I will raise these with my practitioner before any treatment takes place.
